

## REGIONAL BIOPAMA PLANS for 2019-2020

---

Contracting consultants to assist with working on the following projects:

- a. An analysis of **Eastern and Southern African governance and management policies** to gain a better understanding of these across the region, to identify areas for improvement, support and capacity building in 2020
- b. An analysis of **ecosystem services, financing options for protected areas and other tools to support the sustainable financing of protected and conserved areas**. The results of this analysis will be used to prepare for a capacity building workshop in 2020.
- c. The development of a training course for the **Local Communities: First Line of Defence (FLoD) programme**, including related capacity building.

## REGIONAL BIOPAMA PLANS for 2019-2020

- Consultancy to report on management effectiveness, governance and social assessments in the region – challenges, successes, capacity required, etc.
  - Provide information for a **Capacity Building Workshop on Governance, Social and Management Effectiveness Tools** and their implementation. to be held in Zambia in October 2019
- Updating of the **African Natural Heritage Review**, in partnership with IUCN PACO
- **State of Protected and Conserved Areas Report for Eastern and Southern Africa**
  - ✓ **Planning workshop for Eastern Africa** in Nairobi on the 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> February and one for **Southern Africa** in Johannesburg on the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> February.
  - ✓ Publication at the IUCN World Conservation Congress 2020

# REGIONAL BIOPAMA PLANS for 2019-2020

---

- **Tourism concession capacity building workshops** in the region, starting with the Indian Ocean Islands (in partnership with IUCN WCPA TAPAS group)
- **Action Component** – portal is open and the first call for proposals for medium grants is planned for 24<sup>th</sup> June 2019
  - ✓ Proposals assessed by a Regional Advisory Committee (RAC)
  - ✓ Selection done by DG-DEVCO, based on RAC assessment
- **Regional Conservation Forum (RCF), July 2019** – TFCA discussion?
- **RCMRD annual conference, Nairobi, August 2019** – RRH presentations

# BIOPAMA Action Component (AC)

---

- Driven by clearly identified priorities, the BIOPAMA AC establishes a mechanism for mobilising grants in ACP Countries for tangible on-the-ground actions that address key governance and management issues.

The BIOPAMA AC aims to:

- **Enhance the management and governance of priority areas** by addressing existing limitations (strengthening on-site infrastructure/equipment for patrolling, poaching control, developing capacity of staff);
- **Strengthen the legal frameworks** required to achieve effective biodiversity conservation;
- **Support local community initiatives** to enhance the livelihoods of local people whilst effectively contributing to protected area management and governance.
